



## DENNIS H. SCHUPP

Dennis H. Schupp graduated from the University of Minnesota and has been a lifelong employee of the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR). His early years were spent researching the walleye fishery of Minnesota.

In 1970, Dennis left the realm of research to assume duties as a Regional Fisheries Manager, a position he held for four years. He then became the Warmwater Research Supervisor, a position he continues to hold.

His performance over the years has earned Dennis widespread respect as a researcher, scientist and a gentleman. Dennis was an original member of the Minnesota Chapter of the American Fisheries Society. In 1992, he received the DNR John B. Moyle Meritorious Service Award and in 1993, he received the Excellence in Fisheries Science Award from the North Central Division of the American Fisheries Society.
